through July 31. Anyone

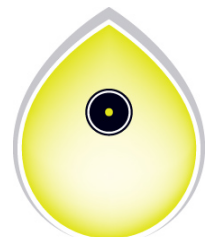

A Rhea of Hope Foundation is a nonprofit organization dedicated to "building awareness and creating opportunities for individuals and families affected by cancer-related fertility issues." According to the [Center for Disease Control and Prevention](#)

in a 2002 study, 7.3 million women between the ages of 15 and 44 experience an impaired ability to have children. But according to the 2009 "nationwide survey of oncologists regarding treatment-related infertility and fertility preservation in female cancer patients" [[Forman et al.](#)], less than half of American oncologists (39 percent to 47 percent) routinely refer patients to specialists in reproductive medicine, despite a concern within the medical community about the potential impact cancer treatments have on fertility. A Rhea of Hope is dedicated to assisting "women, couples and families who struggle to conceive a child" by helping educate not just the public but also health care providers about fertility options, "support research and development of new treatments relating to fertility issues and the causes and diseases that can lead to sterility" and provide financial support for those in need to realize their dream of having children.
